# SPRING 2024 POLICY PRIORITIES

Family farmers, ranchers, and our communities not only need a farm bill now, but they also need the **right** farm bill now. Since 2017, approximately 150,000 farms have gone out of business. We can stem the tide of these losses by establishing a stronger farm safety net, building fairer and more competitive markets, and creating better opportunities for the next generation of farmers. Let's pass this farm bill by building a broad coalition through addition, not division.

## FARM SAFETY NET

- ☑ Provide farmers with more consistent, equitable, and predictable relief when disasters strike.
- ☑ Expand crop insurance coverage options and availability to more farmers and ranchers.
- ☑ Support the Whole Farm Revenue Protection Improvement Act (S. 2598).
- ☑ Allow dual enrollment in Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) and Price Loss Coverage (PLC).

## BROAD AND UNIFIED FARM BILL COALITION

- ☑ Maintain strong food and nutrition security provisions.
- ☑ Protect new funding for voluntary, incentive-based conservation and renewable energy programs.

- ☑ Support the Agricultural Right to Repair Act (H.R. 5604).
- ☑ Support the Cattle Price Discovery and Transparency Act (S. 228/HR. 1287).

## ADDITIONAL PRIORITIES

- ☑ Support the Rural Partnership and Prosperity Act (S. 3309/ H.R. 7444).
- ☑ Support the Farmers First Act (S. 1736/ H.R. 6379), and the Farm and Ranch Stress Assistance Network.
- ☑ Support Next Generation Fuels Act (S. 944/ H.R. 2434).
