



## All-States Leadership Summit Frequently Asked Questions

### What is the deadline for registration?

Please register by May 1, 2025. This helps us coordinate logistics with the hotel, tour buses, and volunteer organizations. If you are a Farmers Union state coordinator and anticipate having a late registration, please contact Lisa Buckner ([lbuckner@nfudc.org](mailto:lbuckner@nfudc.org)).

### I can't pay by credit card, is there an alternate payment method?

The registration portal offers a pay-by-check option. If you are a participant who has been instructed to register by your state Farmers Union division, and your registration is being paid for by your state, please use the pay-by-check option.

If you are not affiliated with a state division, you still have the option to use the pay-by-check option, but credit cards are preferred.

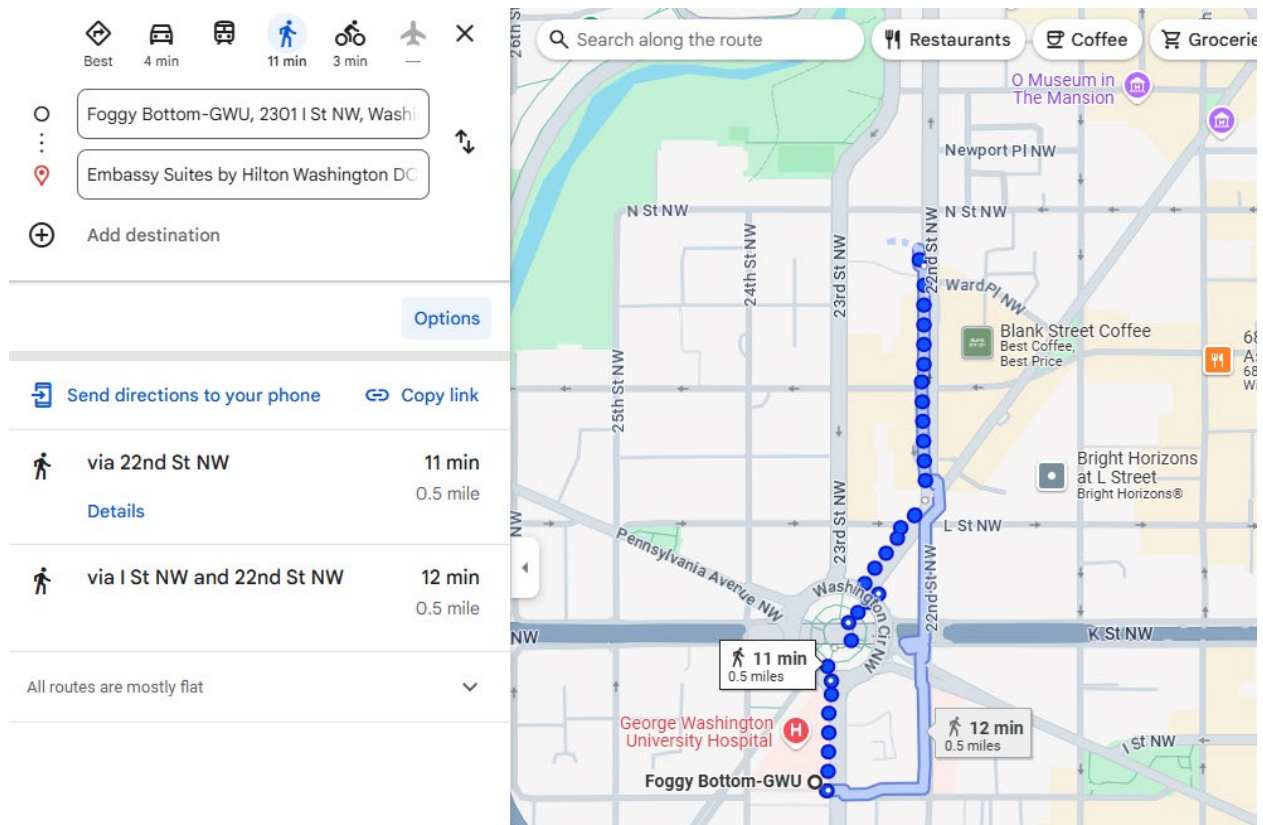
### What airport should I fly into?

The DC/Maryland/Virginia area is serviced by three airports. The closest and easiest airport to use is Ronald Reagan International Airport (DCA). This airport is close to the city center and easily accessed by public transportation.

### How will transportation be organized?

Transportation between the airport and the conference hotel will not be provided. If you are arriving at Ronald Reagan International Airport and wish to travel by Metro:

1. Take the Blue Line from the airport towards Largo Town Center
2. Get off at Foggy Bottom
3. The hotel is an 11 minute walk north from the Foggy Bottom Metro stop



Transportation during the conference to off-site locations (tour locations, volunteering locations, etc.) will be organized by National Farmers Union.

## What are the hotel accommodations? Will I have a roommate?

The conference is taking place at Embassy Suites by Hilton Washington DC Georgetown (1250 22<sup>nd</sup> St NW). Embassy Suites rooms include two double beds and one pull-out couch, so conference participants will be roomed with either one or two roommates.

## Are meals provided?

All meals will be provided *except for*:

- Any meals on your arrival date (May 29)
- Lunch and dinner on your departure date (June 2) (Embassy Suites offers complimentary breakfast)



## How much money should I bring for incidentals?

You will have opportunities to purchase souvenirs and food during our tour-day, during off-hours during the conference, and on your travel day depending on your arrival and departure times. ## What should I pack / what is the dress code?

Business casual attire would be appropriate for this conference. Casual attire can be worn for tour day activities; don't forget comfortable walking shoes! On Saturday, May 31 participants will be volunteering with organizations involved in food distribution or urban farming, so please bring clothing you wouldn't mind getting dirty for these activities. Please consider daily temperatures: highs between 70 and 90 degrees, and lows between 50 and 70 degrees.
